It consists of a few multiple choice questions and open-ended questions.


The collected data are anonymous.

1990-2000: 9 Surveyed


Q.3: Place of Birth

ITALY: 100% Surveyed






### Q.4: Degree of study












Q.6: Do you interacts with migrants, as a citizen, in your municipality?




Q.7: Do you, interact with migrants for work reasons?



# Q.12: Are private bodies involved in the reception process in Italy?








